

## Summer Holiday Provision - 2020

### Organisations that may be able to do summer activities in schools

Active Leaders are able to run leadership courses for young people in Year 10 and above which aims to develop confidence, employability and leadership skills. They have adapted their usual model to deliver remotely to small groups of young people who would then work together on, for example, social action projects.
